Course Delivery

We deliver Certificate II in Animal Studies by distance education, through blended correspondence and e-Learning. Students are provided access to a student portal to complete assessments. Certificate II in Animal Studies students are required to nominate a workplace mentor to guide them throughout their studies. Selected mentors need to be working with the student on a daily basis and must have either completed a current Certificate II in Animal Studies or a higher-level qualification, or hold a supervisory or management role. Mentors will assist students with the on-job learning, read case studies prior to submission and sign off student's Skills Record Logs. Your employer must be agreeable to your choice of mentor.
