A graduate of the Melbourne Veterinary School (1989), Stewart is the Head of the Small Animal Surgery Service in the Faculty of Veterinary and Agricultural Sciences at the University of Melbourne. After several years in mixed dairy cattle and small animal practice in Victoria, he moved to Hong Kong and worked there for the next 10 years. He then moved to Fort Collins, CO, USA and completed an advanced Residency training program in Small Animal Surgery and a Fellowship in Surgical Oncology at the Colorado State University (CSU). Stewart became a Diplomate of The American College of Veterinary Surgeons (ACVS) in 2007 and was an Assistant Professor Faculty member at CSU. He returned to Melbourne in late 2011 and joined the University of Melbourne in October 2012. He is a registered specialist in small animal surgery and the author of many peer-reviewed scientific publications and several book chapters. Stewart's research is focused on surgical oncology, musculoskeletal oncology and limb salvage, the interaction of radiation and bone and translational research for medical devices. He also has clinical interests in minimally invasive surgery, interventional radiology and surgical oncology. He is head of the small animal surgery service at the Veterinary teaching hospital in Werribee.




