Dr. Kittipong Tachampa is a veterinary cardiologist and Assistant Professor at the Department of Physiology, Faculty of Veterinary Science, Chulalongkorn University, where he has served since 1998. He earned his DVM with honours from Chulalongkorn University (1998), an MSc. from Mahidol University (2003), and a PhD in cardiovascular science from the University of Illinois at Chicago (2009). He also completed advanced cardiology training through the European School for Advanced Veterinary Studies (ESAVS).

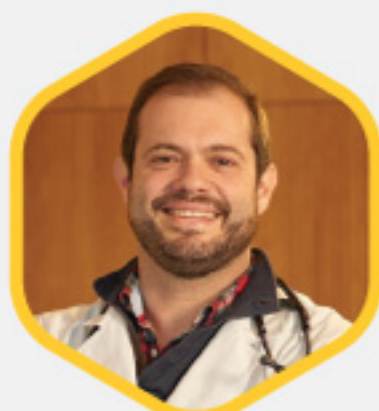
